

MCGP SCHOOL DISCLAIMER

As parent or legal guardian of the student(s) named, above, I give my consent for the student to attend Muslim Center of Greater Princeton ("MCGP") Saturday school. I have received a full and satisfactory description of the schools arrangements, schedules, and costs. For the duration of this school year, during the school hours, I agree that the MCGP School administration and staff shall have such authority as is necessary to maintain order and to ensure the health and safety of the student.

I/We also give my/our consent for him/her/them to participate in school activities and will not hold MCGP responsible in case of an accident, injury or exacerbation of any medical/psychological condition. We hereby agree to hold the MCGP school, its administrative staff, and volunteers harmless from any and all liabilities, actions, causes of action, debts, claims, demands of every kind and nature including losses of any kind whatsoever that may arise by or in connection with the participation by my/our child/children in any activities related to MCGP School program.

Please note that we do not have special arrangements for children with dietary allergies (such as nuts etcetera). Please ensure that you provide your son / daughter with an adequate snack or lunch.

Limitation of Liability. Regardless of the best efforts put forward to protect our students from COVID-19 which are implemented by MCGP and its schools, if any student(s) catches COVID-19 or get sick in anyway, MCGP and its school shall not be liable for any direct or indirect, special or consequential damages, nor for any related claim. You are welcome to visit the MCGP center to look at the physical facility and ask questions to be comfortable before sending your child. Due to physical layout and other constraints like ventilation etc. we cannot make any specific promises for separation or tracing. All arrangements are best effort and can/will change without notice based on ground realities.

All staff and students eligible for the Covid-19 vaccine must be vaccinated before school starts. If any student, 12 and above, is not vaccinated, please report it. We may have to cancel the registration with full refund (on a case by case basis).

All staff and students may be subject to all applicable tests (Covid-19, etc), that are deemed appropriate by the medical staff at MCGP.

All students must wear a mask during school. We encourage parents to teach students the importance of it and ensure compliance.

We may, at any time, move the classes to online temporarily or long term. Decisions will be based on ground realities and reports from NJ Public Schools when they open.

Everyone entering the School must agree to temperature and other relevant checks.

Parent(s) must not send students to school if they show any symptoms or have fever, runny nose etc. and also must notify the teacher and administration team.

Students with any of the following symptoms should not come to class:

- Fever equal to or greater than 100 °F
- Cough
- Sore throat
- Nasal congestion
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea

If a student does test positive for COVID-19, please report it to the school administration and teacher as soon as possible at admin@mcgpschool.org.

Please note that it is the parent's responsibility to arrange for bringing and picking up the student(s) to the school. If parent(s) arrange(s) for the student's pick-up from the classroom or the school, by a third party, without prior written & dated communication with the school principal and classroom teacher, then MCGP assumes no responsibility of the Child after the class session is over.

I have read the below and communicated to my child they are responsible for:

1. Behaving in a manner that does not interfere with the rights of others.
2. Abiding by expectations, guidelines, rules and regulations established by the school and in an Islamic manner
3. Attending school on time
4. Be safe:
 - a. Students should not throw objects at others, push others, or act in any other manner that may cause harm to themselves or another individual.
5. Be respectful:
 - a. Students are to behave in a manner that enhances their and others opportunities to learn.
 - b. Students are to avoid using profanity or other inappropriate language.
 - c. Students are to behave in a manner that allows others a pleasant atmosphere.
6. Be responsible:
 - a. Students are to dress in a reasonable and appropriate manner that does not distract others from learning and follows Islamic guidelines of modesty.
 - b. Students are to attend school regularly.
7. Zero tolerance policy on cell phones and any other electronics during school hours. If a student is seen using such a device, it will be taken away and be returned only to a parent / guardian. These devices can only be used with the administration or teacher's permission. Cell phone use is also permitted for emergencies.

These guidelines include behaviors and disciplinary actions that indicate to the student and parent(s) the seriousness of the behavior and at the same time provide the school personnel with an additional opportunity to aid the student to develop better self-discipline. In all situations, parental/guardian contact shall be made to provide for communication and cooperation in developing positive student behavior. These guidelines apply to conduct occurring on school grounds (including the parking lot), in a vehicle owned, leased or contracted by a school being used for a school purpose or in a vehicle being driven for a school purpose by a school employee or his or her designee or at a school sponsored activity or event.

Fees and Dues: All Registration fees are due in full at time of registration.

Refund Policy: No refunds. Special circumstances will be considered. A written explanation needs to be provided to the administration.
